- A post-performance wrap party with conductor Alasdair Neale at the Embassy Suites Hotel.

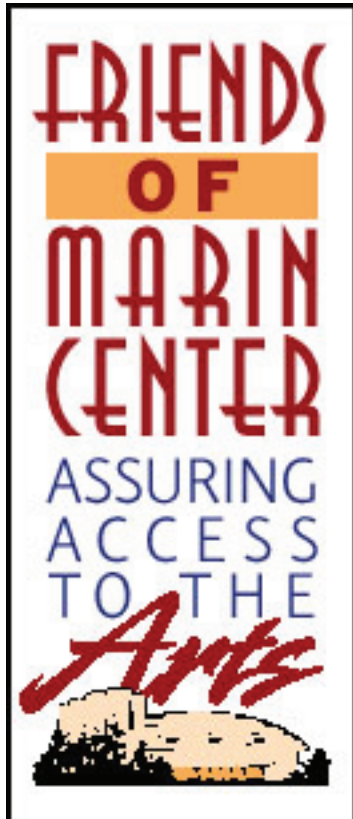
